A * COMPREHENSION

(4 points)

- 1 How is industrialisation affecting the atmosphere?
By intensifying the greenhouse effect.
- 2 Why is it thought that sea levels will change?
Because the ice of the poles is melting.

ARE THESE STATEMENTS **TRUE OR FALSE? JUSTIFY YOUR ANSWERS WITH THE PRECISE WORDS OR PHRASES FROM THE TEXT.**

(0.5 points per answer)

- 3 Nobel Prize winning scientists are not convinced about the consequences of global warming.
False: "Global warming has emerged as the most serious environmental threat of the 21st century. only by taking action now can we ensure that future generations will not be put at risk". (Lines 1-2)
- 4 All gas emissions are harmful for life on Earth.
False: "This is known as the greenhouse effect, and it is this that keeps our planet at a temperature at which life can prosper". (Lines 5-6)
- 5 Over the last 20 years, the world's temperature has gone up more slowly than in the preceding centuries.
False: "Over the past two decades the earth has been warming faster than at any point in the last 1,000 years". (Lines 9-10)
- 6 It is certain that there will be an increase in floods and dry periods.
False: "possible scenarios..." (Line 12)
